

**S.C. State Fair
2010 4-H Stall Decorating Contest**

Purpose

To create a visual display that demonstrates the educational activities of the 4-H Horse Program and Clubs. The theme is "*Horses & the 4-H Pledge*" (how a member's involvement with horses helps him/her successfully accomplish the actions in the 4-H Pledge). Creativity and teamwork is encouraged.

General Rules

- Contest entries must be received by September 10, 2010. Contestants must have their show entries submitted to the SC State Fair (www.scstatefair.org) by Sept. 1, 2010.
- Clubs will be assigned stalls on a first come-first served basis until Barns A & B are filled.
- Stall assignments will be indicated by the placement of stall cards and a master list will be emailed to the club leader prior to the show.
- Each club may request one tack stall per every 5 horses entered. Individual club members should neither request nor pay for tack stalls with their entries.
- Horses may be moved in on Friday, Oct. 15th after 2:00 p.m.
- Stalls must be decorated by 8:00 a.m., Saturday, Oct. 16th and remain decorated through Sunday afternoon. Each club will be responsible for dismantling and disposing of all stall decorations.
- Anything applied to the stall must be safe and removable. Safety and workability around the decorations must be considered. Aisles must be kept clear. The ends of the barns may be decorated, but will not be judged as part of a club's display.
- No electrical devices, including lights, may be used due to potential fire hazard.
- The contest will be judged by committee after 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, Oct 16th.
- A total of 100 points may be awarded.
- Cleanliness of stalls and aisles will be included in the scoring of the contest.
- Winners will be announced on Saturday evening during the Scholarship presentations.
