The South Carolina State Fair announces a change to the 2009 Pepsi Grandstand lineup.

Columbia- The South Carolina State Fair is pleased to announce that Nat and Alex Wolff of the Naked Brothers Band on Nickelodeon will replace Corbin Bleu in this year's Pepsi Grandstand lineup. Corbin Bleu cancelled his fall concert tour last week. "The Nat and Alex Wolff concert will have the same appeal as the Corbin Bleu concert for our younger fair patrons.
